

ORDINANCE NO. 1990-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE UNAUTHORIZED USE AND TAMPERING WITH FIRE HYDRANTS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF


The Board of the Town of Fayal, County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. No person except an officer or employee of the Town of Fayal or a member of a fire department, in carrying out his/her official duties, shall use or tamper with any fire hydrant located within the Town of Fayal, or draw or attempt to draw any water therefrom.


Section 2. Any person who violates this ordinance, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor. A second offense or violation committed within one (1) year of a first offense or violation shall be considered a misdemeanor.

Section 3. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication.

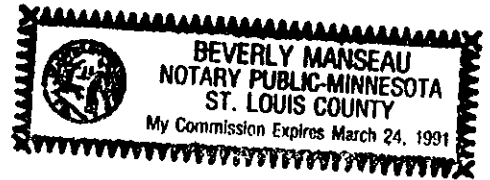

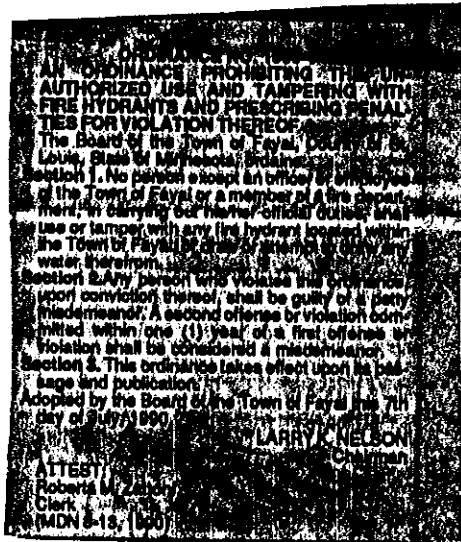
